
OVERVIEW

A day care aide or relative care provider's enrollment must be denied or terminated if the department is made aware that they or an adult household member, age 18 and over, residing in the relative care provider's home, has a pending criminal charge or has been convicted of any of the terminable crimes unless an administrative review of the crime(s) determines he/she is eligible. (See PEM 704, [Administrative Review Process](#).)

The crime code headings derive from offenses identified in the Good Moral Character Rule, R400.1152. Each crime category contains a crime code and title originating from the Prosecuting Attorneys Coordinating Council (PACC), Michigan Compiled Laws (MCL) and the Federal Bureau of Information, National Crime Information Center (NCIC) Arrest Crime (AC) code systems.

If the conviction was outside of Michigan, the charge may have a different code than those listed in the [crime codes exhibit](#). Deny or terminate the enrollment if the general description and/or conviction title is listed.

Finding Codes - PDF Files

When using the online manual PDF files from the public Web site (www.michigan.gov/dhs-manuals), you can quickly locate a specific code by clicking on the 'binoculars' (Search across one or more PDF files) in the Adobe Acrobat toolbar. To Search PDF, enter the charge code number in the field 'What word or phrase would you like to search for?'. Be sure to include the decimal point in the code (i.e., 750.117). Click the 'Search' button. Click on the information returned in the Results panel to go to the page with the code. To view the page full screen, click on the 'Hide' button at the top of the Search PDF panel.
